Don't stress this holiday season,

Call a Caterer

With the holidays right around the corner, it's important to begin thinking ahead, especially in terms of hosting an event or gathering.

Laura Sayers, an advertising representative at Farragut Press and owner of J. Laura Catering, says that her 30 years of experience in the catering business have taught her one thing: if the thought of entertaining is stressful, then it's best to call in a caterer.

"People usually are uncomfortable hosting ten or more people, so a caterer can certainly take the pressure off and can work within your budget," said Sayers, who fell in love with organizing parties and planning menus through a college internship at Hyatt Regency.

Some people, on the other hand, may feel rejuvenated and at ease with entertaining a large group. In that case, Sayers said that cookbooks are an excellent reference to find interesting menu options that can be prepared prior to the event. This way, you can enjoy your guests rather than being stuck in the kitchen.

"A lot of make ahead recipes can be frozen or stored in the fridge and put in the oven an hour before the event," she explained. "While these are in the oven, you can do the last minute trays with cheeses, crackers, dips and snacks."

For larger gatherings, Sayers said that a buffet generally works better, as it encourages more in-

teraction and fellowship. Both buffets and plated meals, however, rely on a proper table presentation to really bring the event together.

"The table presentation is the most important," said Sayers. "You can make bologna sandwiches look good with the right presentation. It doesn't cost a lot either."

For a Christmas gathering, Sayers said that simply adding some greenery, candles and battery operating lights would be enough to make the space look special.

"One cheap bag of ornaments placed around a buffet makes the table sparkle," she added.

Sayers, who entertains up to 12 people every night from December 1-22, emphasized that it's less about what you serve and more about fellowship and making others feel welcome.

"People ask 'How do you do this so many nights in a row?' Well, I have a fantastic husband who loves to be sous-chef and is so supportive of me and wants our home to be open to share the love of friendship in our home," she said. "The food doesn't have to be 'fancy,' just having the warmth of friends around you is all you need."

To gather Passion for coffee, bringing the

community together; define Sunago

Toshua "Tito" Wilson's passion of for coffee began at the age of 19 when he got hired at a local shop in Louisville, Ky. After quickly being promoted to a shift supervisor, Wilson realized his vision of opening a coffee shop of his own.

"Between the community growth and the business lessons I learned, I knew at 20 years old that I wanted to one day own my own coffee company - a company that's entire existence was to change the world one community at a time," he explained. "Big goal, I know, but even if we fail, I don't see how it would be considered a loss."

After working for several different coffee companies everywhere from Iowa to Tennessee, Wilson's dream came to fruition in August with the opening of Sunago Coffee Co. at 10736 Hardin Valley Road.

To gather

When brainstorming names for the company, Wilson said he knew he wanted its foundation to be focused on community development and gathering together. He began searching for words that meant "gather" and came across the Greek word "sunago."

"I immediately knew that was the word," he said.

Meaning "to gather" or "to join two things that were once separated," Sunago is indeed the perfect name for Wilson's business, especially seeing as how coffee brought him and his wife. Yelena, together.

"Unknowingly to me my friends submitted my resume to Starbucks because they overheard the manager talking about needing experienced help," remembered Wilson. "I went in for my interview and sitting

across from me was this cute shift supervisor who I had seen once or twice but never really chatted with her."

After the interview, Wilson joked to his friends that Yelena, who acted "giddy" throughout the interview, probably would have married him if he had asked.

"Six months later, we married and have been married for 11 years now," Wilson said, "We have three kiddos, a Bernedoodle,

two businesses and have lived in three states. It's been a wild ride."

A better community for all

In addition to coffee, a large part of the Wilson's lives have been devoted to humanitarian and mission work.

"Our world traveling has shown us that there are so many hurting people around the world," said Wilson. "It transformed our thinking."

While everyone is subject to having bad days, Wilson said the time spent overseas has helped him remember to be grateful for his own blessings and provisions.

"So many people around the world don't know if they'll eat today, if they'll sleep under the stars or under a roof, if they'll be sold into captivity or live free," he said.

As part of their dedication to helping others, Sunago raises money and awareness for different nonprofit organizations who bring positive change to people's lives. So far, the company has partnered with Tennessee Children's Home and Bridge Refugee Services.

Sunago also offers a Barista Featured Drink each month in which 5 percent of the drink's profits are donated to a nonprofit of the creating barista's choosing.

"It allows for the passions and cares of the team to be highlighted," noted Wilson. "Just something small we can do with the help of the community."

This focus on community is evident in every facet of Sunago.

For example, the company's logo – a constant conversation starter that's often mistaken for the world or a coffee bean – is a symbol of the Japanese art of Kintsugi. A process of restoring broken pottery using melted gold, Kintsugi

actually leaves the pottery more valuable in this imperfect state compared to its original state.

"We like to say that Sunago exists to go into diverse communities to provide a gathering place where the community can come together in a way they haven't before; becoming united towards a common goal of creating a better community for all the different cultures and people groups within," explained Wilson. "We might disagree on some topics, but if we can still gather together and love one another, we will be more valuable as a whole than we were before ... Imperfect still but more valuable because we are all working as one to better the future for our kids and community."

A one-of-a-kind experience

From their menu to their sourcing process, Wilson emphasized that the company's goal is to provide an experience that can only be found at Sunago.

"Our coffee is unlike any other coffee shop," he said.

Not only are they roasted locally in Powell, Sunago's coffee beans come from small farms all across the world that don't use any chemicals during the growing, harvesting or drying processes. These beans are also delivered to the roasting plant soon after being harvested.

"Does that make it more expensive for us? Yes, but the quality speaks for itself," said Wilson, noting that many customers who typically prefer cream and sugar drink Sunago's coffee black. "Our coffee doesn't have that bitter, unwanted aftertaste that almost all others have."

Another aspect that sets Sunago apart from other coffee shops is its internal culture that aims at being "diverse but unified."

"We have a culture of inclusivity and love,"

said Wilson. "Are we perfect? No, but we know as a team, if we live out our Sunago values, we will be an example for the community. It all starts with us putting on an apron and choosing to have an attitude that is unlike another coffee shop. We tell each other 'we're not the ordinary coffee shop,' and we try to live that every day."

Even Sunago's overall atmosphere is one-ofa-kind with all its furniture made by Wilson, who also owns a custom furniture business called Tito Wilson Designs.

"We truly want Sunago to be your home away from home," said Wilson.

Sunago customers are also able to support small businesses throughout the area through the coffee shop's partnerships with more than 30 different local vendors.

"We have customers who come in just to get local macarons, local flower bouquets, local honey and so many other options that help support local businesses," Wilson said. "And the special thing with all of this is we don't take or charge them a penny of their sales. We want to provide a space for other small businesses to experience growth and profits without feeling the burden of cost for using shelf space."

Looking to the future, Wilson has even more big plans for Sunago, including a mobile app and event trailer.

"We've come a long way since Aug. 1, and we're grateful for the community's patience and grace as we grow and learn," he added. "We're so proud of the team and how much they've grown as baristas and people. Seeing them come together to live out the Sunago mission is priceless and such a blessing."







Get gifts there on time

Thanks to families being more spread out than ever before, today's holiday shoppers must figure out ways to get holiday gifts to their destination on time. The holiday season tends to be the busiest time of year for many delivery services. The following tips should help shoppers ensure their loved ones' gifts arrive on time.

· Ship directly.

Adobe Analytics reported that online shopping hit a record high of \$108.2 billion in the 2017 holiday shopping season, and all indicators suggest online shopping will only increase in the years to come. Holiday shoppers who want to ensure their loved ones will receive their gifts on time can rely on online shopping. When checking out, have gifts shipped directly to loved ones' homes. Many online retailers will even wrap gifts for a nominal fee.

Research shipping options.

In 2018, Christmas falls on a Tuesday. Shoppers who plan to rely on two-day or overnight shipping should keep that in mind. Some delivery services may be open throughout the weekend before Christmas, while others may only be open on Saturday. Last-minute shoppers, whether they're shopping online or in-person, should confirm their shipping options well in advance of Christmas. Because Christmas is on a Tuesday this year, getting gifts to their destination on time may require shoppers to purchase and ship them earlier than they otherwise might.

Purchase package insurance.

Consumer Reports notes that UPS and FedEx shipments automatically come with declared-value coverage of up to \$100. (Note: Declared value is the carrier's maximum liability.) Purchasing additional insurance can ease shoppers' concerns about lost or stolen packages. Just be sure to keep all invoices and receipts in case claims must be filed. Shoppers also should ask for tracking numbers on all packages so they can confirm when packages are delivered.

Properly secure the package.

Many delivery services now have off-site drop-off boxes that can make it easy to send gifts. This is a convenient service, but shoppers who use them won't be able to have a company employee provide in-person confirmation that their packages are secured to company standards. Poorly packaged items may never be shipped. Visit the shipping company's website for packaging guidelines, and include a business card and duplicate label inside the package just in case it is damaged after being dropped off.

According to a 2021 survey by the consumer market research firm Hunter, 71 percent of people in the United States plan to continue cooking more at home after the pandemic ends. Increased creativity and confidence in the kitchen, as well as the fact that cooking at home helps to save money and enables one to heat healthier, is driving the ongoing increase in dining in.

When cooking at home, cooks can consider various tips to make meals that much healthier.

- Increase fiber intake. Fiber improves bowel regularity and helps a person feel full between meals. High fiber foods also help stabilize blood sugar levels. Two servings of fibrous foods at each meal and an additional fiber-rich snack each day can ensure your body is getting the fiber it needs.
- Slow down eating. The pace at which a person eats a meal can affect his or her overall health. Healthline reports that fast eaters are more likely to eat more and have higher body mass indexes than slow eaters.
- Choose whole grains. Choosing whole grain breads or cereals over refined grains can make for a more nutritious diet. Whole grains are linked to a reduced risk for type 2 diabetes, heart disease and cancer.
- Swap Greek yogurt for other varieties. Greek yogurt contains up to twice as much protein as regular yogurt, providing roughly 10 grams per 3.5 ounces. Protein along with fiber helps a person feel fuller longer, which can manage appetite and reduce overeating. Greek yogurt also can replace mayonnaise or sour cream in certain recipes.
- Add a vegetable to every meal. Vegetables are loaded with essential vitamins and minerals. Plus, they tend to be high in antioxidants that strengthen the immune system. Increase vegetable intake by eating vegetables with every meal.
- Choose healthy fats. While a person should minimize the amount of oils and other fats used during the cooking process, when it's necessary for a recipe, select the best fat possible. Olive oil is a monounsaturated fat that is packed with antioxidant polyphenols. It is considered a heart-healthy oil, and it may promote a healthy brain and memory function.



Adhering to a nutritious diet can be challenging at any time of year, and especially so during the holiday season. Baked goods and big meals are at seemingly every turn, and that can test even the most devoted dieters. In fact, a 2016 study published in the New England Journal of Medicine found that the average American's weight increases by

0.4 percent over Christmas and0.2 percent over Thanksgiving.

Curiously, the researchers found that the majority of weight gain occurs in the **10 days after Christmas.**






